Short Synopsis:

Dawn of Melancholy: A Birthday Soliloquy, ruminates on the passage of time, reproduction, and meaning making as the lines between recorded, enhanced, and artificial reality become blurred. The viewer is implicated in an existential crisis when they inadvertently release a digital copy of the artist from the confines of the video through augmented reality.

Director's Statement:

This experimental video is embedded with augmented reality triggers that are viewable via the Hoverlay app. Please follow the instructions in the video to download the app and view the augmented content on your personal mobile device when prompted.

In our digitized contemporary reality we are in the present yet are often observing images recorded in the past that are overwriting “the now”. Thus, media recordings are like looping time machines making fabricated and past realities seen and enabling these to hijack presence. In Dawn of Melancholy: A Birthday Soliloquy, we join the artist for an early morning swim in the South Saskatchewan River (Canada) on her birthday as she ruminates on the passage of time, reproduction, and representation. The viewer is implicated in an existential crisis when they inadvertently release a digital copy of the artist from the confines of the video through augmented reality. The layers that construct the video start to peel away revealing recorded, enhanced, and artificially created experience, passing through various states of precarity finally culminating in an explosion.
